For meetings conducted via videoconferencing, the same request to speak procedure shall be followed. The Council Hearing Room is open to the public although members of the City Council may be participating from remote locations that will be visible and audible on video screens located inside the room. **Face coverings are required in the Council Hearing Room and will be available if needed.** Persons who have signed up to speak may address the Council from the podium located inside the Council Hearing Room, or may do so from a remote location. Login information to participate via videoconference will be provided prior to the meeting. For those wishing to speak via teleconferencing, please provide a phone number and someone will call you before the public comments portion of the agenda to place you in a queue. If you do not have computer access to complete the form, please call 405.742.8209 for assistance.

NOTE: Should a connection with any one of the City Councilors present for the videoconference be lost, the meeting will be recessed up to a maximum of 30 minutes to re-establish the connection. If reconnection is not possible, the meeting will be reconvened on March 9, 2021 at 5:30 p.m.

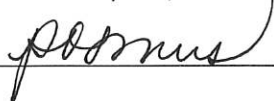
