1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Joyce called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

2. CONSENT DOCKET

- a. Approve March 10, 2025 meeting minutes.
- b. Approve budget amendments to fund increased overtime related to the engine overhaul at the Stillwater Energy Center.

Trustee Hardin pulled Item B. for discussion.

MOTION BY TRUSTEE CLARK, SECOND BY TRUSTEE HAWKINS TO APPROVE ITEM A. ON THE CONSENT DOCKET.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS NOT SCHEDULED FOR PUBLIC HEARING

There were no requests to speak on agenda items not scheduled for public hearing.

4. ITEMS REMOVED FROM CONSENT DOCKET

Trustee Hardin asked for information related to status and cost of the rebuild.

Loren Smith, Electric Utility Director, explains that this is the first major overhaul of one of the three engines at Energy Center; engine hours at approximately 22,000; had disabled the engine down to the crank shaft; components shipped out for rebuild. Loren explains that when the overhaul plan was not fully developed when the FY25 budget was submitted; have had to increase overtime for FY25 budget; and during the rebuild process, staff has worked 7 days a week, 12 hours per day for days on end.

Loren states that the project was on time when engine was back up but after eight hours of operation it was discovered that there was exhaust in the coolant; evaluation and conversation with Wartsila and MSHS determined possible bad seals in the rebuilt kit; new seals are being expedited to Stillwater for installation.

Trustee Hardin asked if Stillwater staff has been doing rebuild; Loren responds that yes, it was City of Stillwater staff with testing being performed by Wartsila; Wartsila was on-site to commission the unit;

and have an ex-Wartsila staff member on City staff which is a great benefit. Loren added that attempts were made to have Wartsila staff on location but due to staffing issues, there were none available.

Trustee Hardin asked about number of units; Loren advises there are three units.

5. GENERAL ORDERS

Senior Project Manager Chris Humes explains project, project area, being at 90% of design and a third of easements acquired; project area is from Western to Kings Streets and University to 6th Avenue with a planned sewer line repair at County Club and 6th Avenue as well as improving 85 manholes through Stillwater; and funding sources.

Trustee Hardin asked about this being an increase in cost. Chris responds that the project concept was five years ago, easement acquisition was budgeted and planned to be done in-house, however, it had to be outsourced, ownerships have changed, RJN fees have increased and scope of work has changed.

Trustee Clark asked if this is related to the Highway 51 reconstruction. Chris responds no.

Chair Joyce asked for staff's recommendation.

Chris presents recommendation which is to

- Approve contract amendment #2 for a fee of \$574,446 for the West College Sewer Project;
- Authorize the General Manager to execute contract amendment #2 and related documents;

Previous/Related Action:	
Background/Issue:	The Stillwater Wastewater Treatment Plant currently performs beneficial land application of biosolids that remain from the treatment process. The application process consists of subsurface injection onto approximately 280 acres of City-owned land that is immediately around the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The current injection unit is a 2011 road truck modified for field use. This unit is on our CIP, is in poor condition, and is due for replacement. Staff researched options and determined that an ag tractor and injection trailer are the best option for sludge injection and other field maintenance needs. Bids for a Liquid Biosolids Sludge Injection Trailer Unit were opened on March 5th, 2025. One bid was received from Minnesota Ag Shortline Specialists in the amount of \$171,250 and it meets specifications. Oklahoma Statewide Contracts were searched and utilized to obtain a quote for an appropriate ag tractor for pulling and operating the injection unit. P&K Equipment provided a quote, via Oklahoma State Contract SW0196JD, in the amount of \$371,511.14 for a John Deere 7R 310 ag tractor.
Proposal/Solution:	• Award bid #5-2025 to Minnesota Ag Shortline Specialists as low responsible bidder meeting specifications and approve purchase of a liquid biosolids sludge injection trailer unit in an amount not to exceed \$188,375, which contains 10% contingency. • Approve the purchase of a John Deere 7R 310 Tractor via Oklahoma Statewide Contract SW0196JD in an amount not to exceed \$390,087, which includes 5% contingency, from P&K Equipment.
Financial Source/Impact:	This proposal requires two (2) new appropriations and budget amendments for the following are included: • Budget Amendment in the amount of \$188,375, which contains 10% contingency, from the SUA Wastewater Fund. • Budget Amendment in the amount of \$390,087, which contains 5% contingency, from the SUA Wastewater Fund.
