• **Call Meeting to Order**

Chairman Brad Rickelman called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm and asked for roll call.

**2a. Review and approval of June 26, 2025, regular meeting summary.**

Mr. Gose moved to approve meeting summary; Mr. Whitworth seconded.

**2b. Transportation Sales Tax Fund financial report – Jared Thulin**

- Referring to the attached Transportation Sales Tax Fund report, Accounting Manager Jared Thulin reported that sales tax collections for June were \$990,247, which exceeded the year-to-date budget; he also stated that the budget did increase from \$10 million to \$10,350,000 to reflect increases they were seeing in sales tax throughout the year.
- He reported total payments of \$1,660,280, which included \$227,920 to Ellsworth Construction for Airport/Park/Harned Reconstruction (20TR06-B) to complete that project.
- Line 28 (FY 25 Pavement Management) included a payment of \$196,062 to Rudy Construction for full-depth repair and \$39,001.84 to Scodeller for crack sealing.
- Line 30 (Knoblock, 4th Avenue, and Lincoln) had a payment of \$115,006.65.
- Line 31 (McElroy, Manning, and Hall of Fame) had a payment of \$130,006.99 to Rudy Construction.
- Line 32 (Monticello) had a payment of \$308,008.75 to Ellsworth Construction.

- Jared reported that there were no major budget amendments or revisions; no POs were issued; and there were no changes to Future Projects/Funding Needs at the bottom of the report.
- Mr. Whitworth inquired about the breakdown of projects in the FY21 Pavement Management Program, and Jared stated that he failed to provide it this time but would include it at next month's meeting.
- Referring to the attached Transportation Fee Fund report, Jared explained that this report shows collections over the previous five years and how much has been expended out of the fund to show what the cash balance was as of June 30.
- He noted that 2025 had a large increase in collections because of the data center, the high school, and the Hub.
- Jared explained that the Transportation Fee Fund can be used for the purpose of planning, designing, and constructing capacity enhancements to the city's transportation system, and it is collected on new commercial buildings, commercial buildings expanding over 25%, and new residential homes.
- The committee discussed the use of the Transportation Fee Fund for various projects, including signal lights and the Rails-to-Trails project. Jared also shared that \$700,000 was used in 2023 for the Third Street Bridge. No action was taken.

**2c. Discussion and possible action to make recommendations to the City Council regarding the proposed sequence or timing of commencement, continuance, and/or completion of transportation projects for which revenues from the 2022 Transportation Sales Tax are to be used including, but not limited to, discussion and possible action for the following specific projects:**

- **Pavement Management Plan for FY2026**
- **10th and Main Roundabout**
- **Main Street signalized intersections (7th, 8th, and 9th)**
- Referring to the attached report "Status of Various Transportation Projects," Director of Engineering Bill Millis provided updates on the following projects:
  - Crack Sealing (25TR07) – This project is moving quickly because the crew from Scodeller has 13 or 14 people and four or five vehicles; they finished two miles of 19th, some Country Club, Western, Duck, and Main. Next, they're going to Richmond west of Washington and Husband near the high school, and they will finish near the hospital.
  - Diamond Grind (25TR05) – This work is being done by Rudy Construction; they've done some really good full-depth repair work at the Hall of Fame/Washington and Hall of Fame/Duck intersection.
  - Full Depth Repairs (FDR) (25TR06) – The eighth work order (of an estimated 12 to 15) has been completed.
  - Windsor Drive Crosswalk Improvements (25TR11) – Estimated final completion date is August 1.
  - Deferred Maintenance (26TR02) – Advertised for bid July 19.
  - Mrs. Brown inquired about the timeline on the Monticello project (25TR08), and Bill stated that the schedule calls for substantial completion in mid-December.
- Referring to the attached two-page draft of the FY26 Pavement Management Plan, Bill reminded the group that last month's draft totaled \$16 million; this month's draft has been revised to total \$10 million based on feedback from the committee.

- The Tyler and Lewis project was removed because it's in the FY25 plan.
- The work on 26th Avenue had been listed for design and construction, and it has been changed to just design with the assumption that construction will be done in a future fiscal year.
- The pedestrian corridor has also been changed to just design.
- Mr. Gose requested Lewis Street in front of City Hall be added to the project.
- There was discussion about the 19th and Western intersection project, including drainage and sidewalk improvements.
- Bill explained that the proposed Supplement Construction Funding for Legacy Project is an effort to address the concern that FY 21 and 22 projects are still not completed yet. There was a consensus that the project name needs to be more specific.

Mr. Gose made a motion to recommend approval of the Draft FY26 Pavement Management Plan and Breakdown to City Council. Mr. Whitworth seconded.

- Regarding the 10th and Main Roundabout, Bill reported that there is a consultant looking at it to make recommendation for improvements.
- Mrs. Brown asked what kind of feedback has been received on the downtown stoplights, and Bill and City Manager Brady Moore both reported that the response has been significantly positive.
- Bill reminded the group that the county is planning to pave Sangre Road from Virginia to Lakeview, and this will leave an approximate quarter mile gap of gravel within city limits from Virginia south to the bridge. The City is working with the county to do this work cooperatively so the City doesn't have to come back later and complete a quarter-mile project.
- Bill reported that Public Works has started on some of the patches on the 19th Avenue shared use path, mostly from Western to Sangre, that are not due to AT&T damage.
- Referencing a question from last month's meeting about the capacity of the City to acquire a crack sealing machine and have Public Works do some repairs in-house, Bill reported that the City does have a crack sealing machine that is currently under repair; however, the process is more than just the machine because there are several different types of crack repair, and that requires different materials and equipment. The preliminary estimate for Public Works was six to seven staff plus vehicles, so it has not been pursued in depth.

**2d. Discussion, consideration, and possible action regarding sidewalks, including sidewalk maintenance and improvements currently included and budgeted for in the Pavement Management Program, and other sidewalk projects that may be funded from the Transportation Sales Tax Fund.**

- i. **Discussion, consideration, and possible action regarding a project addressing various sidewalk improvements throughout the City.**

- Referring to the attached report “Sidewalk Request Spreadsheet,” Bill reported there is a kickoff meeting with consultant Gose and Associates for the design contract for the FY25 batch of \$200,000.
- He drew attention to the attached report “Sidewalk & Street Monthly Reporting” from Public Works so that the committee could see the progress being done. Mr. Rickelman suggested this information be included on the City website.
- Mr. Gose mentioned the importance of adequate signage and the importance of public communication about ongoing projects.
- Mrs. Brown suggested moving sidewalk repairs to the north side of 7th Avenue in Pecan Hill for cost efficiency.

**2e. Discussion, consideration, and possible direction to staff on proposed projects to be funded from the revenues generated by the 2022 Transportation Sales Tax.**

- There were no comments.  
No action was taken.

**3. Public Comment on Items not Scheduled for Public Hearings**

- The Stillwegian founder Chris Peters commented about the importance of media coverage and public awareness of road projects, sharing that when he was editor at Newspress, he included road projects and road closures on the website, and that has stopped since he is no longer there.

**4. Reports from Committee Members and Staff**

- Next scheduled meeting is August 28, 2025.
- Mrs. Brown inquired about how to find out construction details, and the committee discussed the challenges of obtaining information on private construction projects.
