1. Call Meeting to Order

Chair Amy Dzialowski called the meeting to order at 4:01 p.m.

2. General Orders

The board/committee/commission will hear a staff presentation and take action including a vote or series of votes on each item listed as presented or as amended or revised by members of the board/committee/commission unless the agenda entry specifically states no action will be taken. The requested action is indicated in each agenda entry but may be amended or revised prior to action by the board/committee/commission.

a.	Visitor Tax Financial Report. No action will be taken on this item. Assistant City Manager and Finance Director Christy Cluck presented the Visitor Tax Financial Report and answered the Committee's questions.
b.	Presentation and discussion of current and proposed status of Washington School redevelopment and improvements, including a current needs assessment, and discussion of the building's future use for education, sports recreation, events and parking which will be a visitor and community amenity of historical importance. No action will be taken on this item. Deputy City Manager Christy Driskel presented the history and background of the Washington School. She reported that a dinner was held by the Washington School Heritage Foundation to raise money to acquire the school. Ms. Driskel discussed the condition of the school and the demolition that needs to be done which includes asbestos abatement. The roof cover has been torn off the school so fixing the roof is a priority before any other improvements are made. Ms. Driskel presented the estimates of the renovation: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Demolition: \$119,000• Asbestos Abatement: \$24,720• Roof Repair: \$124,000

She reported that the Washington School Heritage Foundation has raised \$140,000 to go towards the roof repair. Ms. Driskel presented the future restoration look of the Washington School.

Discussion was held regarding the funding for the restoration; ball fields and other projects related to the Washington School renovations. City Manager Brady Moore and Deputy City Manager Christy Driskel answered the Committee's questions.

c. Discussion, consideration, and possible action to make a recommendation to SEDA to authorize expenditures from the Visitor Amenities Fund for the purpose of development and maintenance of visitor development amenities for the city specifically described as demolition of accessory structures and asbestos abatement at the Washington School Building, and approving transfer of those funds to a City Council project account for this specific purpose.

MOTION BY WAITS, SECOND BY NORRIS TO RECOMMEND STILLWATER ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO AUTHORIZE UTILIZING EXPENDITURES FROM THE VISITOR AMENITIES FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF VISITOR DEVELOPMENT AMENITIES IN THE CITY SPECIFICALLY AS ASBESTOS ABATEMENT AND DEMOLITION OF ACCESSORY STRUCTURES AT THE WASHINGTON SCHOOL BUILDING AND APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000 WITHIN 18 MONTHS TO COMPLETE THE WORK TO A CITY PROJECT ACCOUNT FOR THAT SPECIFIC PURPOSE.
