- Nabar said he would like to examine international diversification options at a future meeting.**

Vanguard has transferred the legacy Library Trust Mutual Fund to a brokerage account. The Trust must now complete a Vanguard restriction removal to be able to make transactions. Part of the paperwork requires listing signees for the account. The board discussed having DeLano be the only signee initially so that she can get the restrictions removed from the account. The topic of signees will be revisited at a future meeting.

Francisco/Nabar moved to appoint library director Stacy DeLano as the signee to the Vanguard Brokerage Account. The votes are as follows: Nabar, yes; Hartman, yes; Francisco, yes; Simpson, yes. Motion approved
